

DIAGONAL
BLOCK 11 of KAL “12 Blocks for Xmas”

- CO 47 sts with US 8 (5 mm) needles.
- With US 7 (4.5 mm) needles, knit 4 rows.
- Continue working in **Diagonal Stitch** with 3 garter sts at one side and 2 garter sts at the other (there's a ROW-BY-ROW instruction below) until you have a total length of 9.25" (23.5 cm).
- Knit 4 rows.
- Bind off with US 8 (5 mm) needle. Cut yarn and weave in ends.

DIAGONAL STITCH WITH 3 AND 2 GARTER STS AT THE SIDES: ROW BY ROW

Repeat instructions between brackets as many times as needed for each row. For this block, make them a total of 7 times, horizontally.

Row 1) (RS) k3, [p2, k4], k2

Row 2) k2, [p4, k2], k3

Row 3) k3, [p2, k4], k2

Row 4) k2, [p4, k2], k3

Row 5) k3, [k2, p2, k2], k2

Row 6) k2, [p2, k2, p2], k3

Row 7) k3, [k2, p2, k2], k2

Row 8) k2, [p2, k2, p2], k3

Row 9) k3, [k4, p2], k2

Row 10) k2, [k2, p4], k3

Row 11) k3, [k4, p2], k2

Row 12) k2, [k2, p4], k3

When you finish row 12), start again from row 1) to work the next repeat of this part.

I knitted 5 times rows 1) to 12), and then rows 1) to 3) to reach the total length of 9.25" (23.5 cm).
