

FLAGS
BLOCK 1 of "52 SQUARE PICKUP" KAL

- CO 43 sts with US 7 (4.5 mm) needles.
- With US 6 (4 mm) needles, knit 4 rows.
- Continue working in **FLAGS Stitch** with 4 garter sts at each side (there is a ROW-BY-ROW instruction below) until you have a total length of 8" (20.5 cm).
- Knit 4 rows.
- Bind off with US 7 (4.5 mm) needle. Cut yarn and weave in ends.

FLAGS STITCH with 4 GARTER STS at each side: Row-by-row

Repeat instructions between brackets as many times as needed. For this block, make them a total of 4 times.

Row 1) (RS) k4, k1, [p1, k6], p1, k5, k4

Row 2) k4, p4, k2, [p5, k2], p1, k4

Row 3) k4, k1, [p3, k4], p3, k3, k4

Row 4) k4, p2, k4, [p3, k4], p1, k4

Row 5) k4, k1, [p5, k2], p5, k1, k4

Row 6) k4, k6, [p1, k6], p1, k4

When you finish row 6), start again from row 1) to work the next repeat of the pattern.

I knitted 9 times rows 1) to 6), and then row 1) to reach the total length of 8" (20.5 cm).
