

SMALL GARTER DIAGONAL  
BLOCK 31 of "52 SQUARE PICKUP" KAL  
by Cecilia Fameli

- CO 43 sts with US 7 (4.5 mm) needles.
- With US 6 (4 mm) needles, knit 4 rows.
- Continue working in **SMALL GARTER DIAGONAL** Stitch with 4 garter sts at each side until you have a total length of 8" (20.5 cm).
- Knit 4 rows.
- Bind off with US 7 (4.5 mm) needle. Cut yarn and weave in ends.

**SMALL GARTER DIAGONAL** Stitch Pattern with 4 **GARTER STS** at each side: **Row-by-row**

Row 1) (RS) k all sts

Row 2) k4, k1, p2, [k2, p2], k4

Row 3) k all sts

Row 4) k4, p2, k1, [k1, p2, k1], k4

Row 5) k all sts

Row 6) k4, p1, k2, [p2, k2], k4

Row 7) k all sts

Row 8) k4, k2, p1, [p1, k2, p1], k4

When you finish row 8), start again from row 1) to work the next repeat of the pattern.

I knitted 6 times the entire pattern, and then rows 1) to 7) again to reach the total length of 8" (20.5 cm)

**SMALL GARTER DIAGONAL** Stitch Pattern – **CHART**

- Read all odd rows from right to left, and all even rows from left to right.
- Work the grey painted part as many times as the pattern calls for (8 times horizontally, in the case of this block).
